

## Code of Conduct Pegasus Scout Network

- 1. We respect and listen to everyone, whatever their background.
- 2. **We take bullying seriously, it's not just banter.** Behaviours include name calling, violence, threats, rumour spreading, leaving others out and hiding belongings.
- 3. We help and support others when they are in need, in distress or being bullied. We do not stand by and do nothing.
- 4. We use mobile phones respectfully when at Network. If an activity leader asks for phones to be kept away, we follow this.
- 5. **We leave the HQ tidy** at the end of the session including washing up anything used and putting tables, chairs and items away.
- 6. We pay subs when due and complete any paperwork needed in a timely fashion.
- 7. **The law and policies of the Scouts apply at all times.** The rules can be found at scouts.org.uk/por.
- 8. **We pitch in and help run the Network wherever possible.** This spreads the workload and makes it manageable for everyone.
- 9. Organisers will let the Network know by the evening before what the activity is. They should also prepare a risk assessment for it and have a backup activity planned in case of poor weather.
- 10. We let the group know if we can't go to Network.
