General Site Rules / Conditions of Use

1. **Fires** are restricted to the Camp Fire Circle and the concrete cooking bases-these have steel fire grates.
2. **No fires** on the ground or fire pits.
3. There are **NO FACILITIES ON SITE FOR DISPOSAL OF RUBBISH**.
Please see separate information about rubbish disposal.
4. **No wet pits** to be dug on site. You may use surface wet pits on the field boundaries and then burn the remains / filter material / take home or take to the Council dump.
5. Please keep the **volume** of musical / audio equipment and campers to a minimum between the hours of **10pm & 7am** to protect our neighbours' ears!
6. The area outside the perimeter fence belongs to Forestry England. Their Bylaws dictate all off-site activities in the Forest—wide games, hikes, cycle trips etc.
7. We are not allowed to collect fallen wood from the Forest floor or of course damage live trees.
8. For obvious health reasons, dogs are not permitted on site, with the exception of guide dogs.
9. **Water points** are positioned down the right-hand side of the site adjacent to the **fire bases** – our **water is metered** so please use it carefully to avoid waste. **All water is drinkable**. There are **no holding tanks except for the hot water heaters**.
10. There is toilet paper provided in each cubicle to “get you started” – please provide your own for the rest of your stay.
11. The **main track** leading to the site is privately owned – please **do not park** along it or on the verges.
12. Forestry England have “planted” dragon’s teeth along the short track leading to the site. **Vehicles** may be parked within the compound. **It is recommended that vans / mini-busses are parked outside due to the gradient of the car park**. Vehicles are not allowed onto the camping area.
13. Caravans and camper vans are not allowed due to planning restrictions.
14. The fenced off area behind the Camp Fire Circle is Out of Bounds for safety reasons.
15. Please **do not wash pots, pans, plates etc in the washbasins or showers**. This causes permanent damage to the surface of the basins.
16. Visiting Leaders are responsible for carrying out **Risk Assessments** for all activities relating to their camp.
17. Please **keep the gates closed at all times**. The ponies think our grass is wonderful and if they get in, they are almost impossible to get out!
18. Please **try to arrive after 1.00pm. on Summer Saturday’s** – this will allow our volunteers a bit of time to check the site and carry out any minor maintenance.
19. Please **try to vacate the site by 11.00am. on Summer Saturday’s** so that we can do No.18 above!
20. **Site Fees** include water, hot showers, electricity and all on site facilities. There are no “extras”
21. There are no cooking facilities in the “kitchen”. Site users are responsible for providing all cooking equipment including gas cookers / gas.
22. We do not have a BBQ but you are welcome to bring your own.
23. Firewood is brought in when available. There may be times when there is none or very little on site. Please check with the Warden.
24. **Please use wood responsibly - use what you need to, not what you want to.**
25. The site is “double fenced”—please do not allow youngsters to climb over them.
26. There must be an adult (18 or over) staying on site at night if there are any young people under the age of 18 camping. The site is isolated and this is for their safety.
27. There are **fire extinguishers** in the **main building and lean-to**. There are also **fire buckets** and **full dustbins** located by the Camp Oven. Leaders are responsible for arranging their own fire safety precautions / rules.
28. **Please complete the “When You Leave” check sheet before departure.**
This is on a clipboard by the door into the “kitchen” area.

Please leave the site / buildings / facilities and equipment as you would like to find them.

**We are sure that you will appreciate that this is a special site in the middle of the
New Forest National Park.**

Please treat the site and the area with respect and maintain high camping standards.
